Your Deposits are Insured

Sno Falls Credit Union accounts are federally insured by the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) to aggregate of \$100,000, and IRAs are insured to an aggregate of \$250,000 at each credit union.



E-Statements – Coming Soon!

Save clutter, shredding time, and trees by switching to free paperless statements.

View your statements the minute they are ready instead of waiting for mail delivery.

You'll receive an email notifying you that your statement is available for viewing online.

Reduce your risk of fraud and identity theft—paper statements can be stolen through trash and mail.

Access up to 36 months of past statements online for record-keeping, taxes, etc.

Here's how to sign up: Click on the Home Banking icon on the top navigation bar on our website www.snofalls.com. From there just follow the directions.

Cardholders receive 1 point for each \$1.00 spent using a Sno Falls Visa Credit Card. Points accrue with each purchase and can be redeemed for either airline miles or merchandise*. This includes all airlines except Southwest and Jet Blue.

* No points are earned for finance charges, fees, cash advances, convenience checks, foreign transaction currency conversion or insurance charges posted to their account. Cardholders see their rewards points on each monthly Visa statement and/or they can be viewed at www.scorecardrewards.com. Reward points expire 6 years from date of purchase.
